BECCA

TODD

You saw your shrink one time five years ago and when I asked you how it went, the only thing you mentioned was how nice her pillows were. You're so in control. You act like you're forty.



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Thank you. This has been a hard day for me and that really makes me feel better.

TODD

That's not a compliment. Look, I'm really impressed by you. You're crushing it. But you're twenty-five, and you go *inside* the branch to do your banking. Just use the ATM. Start living.

BECCA

Tough talk coming from the guy whose bachelor pad is our parents' basement.

TODD

I'm telling you, you've got some real stuff to deal with.

BECCA

What am I supposed to deal with? How

Mom and Dad lied to me for twenty

years? How I don't know who the hell

my biological mother is? How I'm

obviously not who I thought I was? And

now that crazy girl inside wants to be

my sister?

TODD

Yeah. Pick one.

BECCA

I don't want to. I thought I had dealt with this and filed everything away, then Jesi showed up at my office.

TODD

And I'm pretty sure she's not going anywhere. Your whole life plan isn't going to fall apart if you go have a drink with her.

A BEAT, THEN BECCA FINALLY GIVES IN.

BECCA

Okay. But only if you come with me.

TODD

Just for one drink, then I have to go.

Mom is making enchiladas. If I'm not
home in time, she won't pay my car
insurance.

BECCA

You're a grown ass man. After we figure out my shit, we're gonna talk about yours.
