TINA (30, impressive, all business) gives the presentation to Miles who sits and watches...

START →

TINA

This video of career petty criminal, Gary Glenn, went viral 9 months ago after he punched a grocery clerk during a failed shoplifting in Van Nuys, California.

ON THE SCREEN: Gary races through traffic, hurdles fences, cuts on a dime... causing COP CARS to SKID/CHANGE DIRECTION ABRUPTLY/SMASH INTO EACH OTHER/ETC.

Miles watches carefully - studying, processing...

TINA (CONT'D)

12 police cruisers and 2 helicopters following his every move and it still took them 28 minutes, 8 seconds to apprehend him. Running almost a half-hour at full throttle. Forensics found something particularly interesting--

She nods to FORENSICS EXPERT who clears his/her throat...

FORENSICS EXPERT

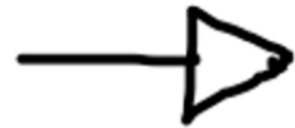
Yes, we calculated distance traveled and were able to determine the subject's last mile was faster than his first. He didn't just survive under pressure, he thrived.

60 days for simple assault and resisting arrest - currently on parole.

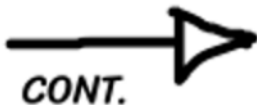

TINA (CONT'D)

No job, panhandles on Ventura, sleeps at a YMCA. But our Psych Division believes he would be motivated to participate, not just by money, but by ego.

DR. MARTELL (40's) speaks up, consults his NOTES...

DR. MARTELL

That is correct. A look at Mr. Glenn's criminal record and school files indicate Malignant Grandiose Narcissism. It's my belief the more you talk up the abilities of our world-class hunters, the more Glenn would be determined to best them. To not participate in the game would be to admit he's not superior to others, something he can't do--

MILES

(holds up his hand)

--I've heard enough, Dr. Martell. In fact, I should've stopped this presentation after the first 10 words.

(to Tina)

Tina, do you remember your first 10 words?

TINA

(checks notes, a bit thrown)

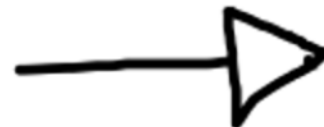
Um... *This video of career petty crook Gary Glenn went viral?*

MILES

Exactly. Went viral. Now, why would I want a runner that *millions* of people have seen on YouTube and Twitter and Lord knows what else? Why would I want a participant in a secretive game when he *himself* is not secret? Why draw that attention to what we do?

TINA

We considered that. The news cycle is so fast and the human attention span is so limited, we're confident risk of Glenn's dubious celebrity interfering with the game is minimal. Our Digital team has been scrubbing the video from the web; views have fallen to almost negligible numbers--

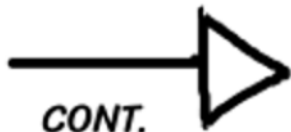

MILES  
--"Almost" negligible is not negligible--

TINA  
(trying to save the pitch)  
--Respectfully, sir, Gary Glenn is a *fantastic* candidate - from his physical attributes to his psychological profile. To dismiss him out of hand would be foolish.

Tina came off a little "hot" - bordering on disrespectful. So Miles just stares at her. Unblinking. So intimidating. Room is silent. Then... "end of discussion"...

MILES  
(pointed)  
Next.

Tina has been "checked". She swallows...

TINA  
Of course.

She clicks a button and a PHOTO of a WOMAN (22) - the photo is her SECURITY ID for HARRISON-LEWIS HEDGE FUND.

TINA (CONT'D)  
Banking gets credit for this one. They discovered Jacqueline Tewksbury - hot shot hedge fund analyst at Harrison-Lewis. Competitive swimmer, top of her class at Emory. She's been embezzling since her first month on the job - her profile indicates an acute appetite for risk-taking...

But Miles has seemed aggravated since almost the moment the woman's photo was put on-screen. He throws up his hands..

MILES  
Of course she's a risk-taker! How old is this child?

TINA  
22.

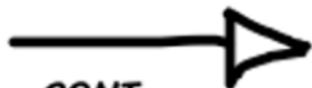
MILES  
(knows the answer)  
Dr. Martell, at what age is the human brain fully developed?

DR. MARTELL  
On average? 25.

MILES

Prior to that age, is someone less likely to be able to cope with certain stressors? Such as physical trauma, death of a loved one or, I don't know, being hunted to the death?

DR. MARTELL

(so uncomfortable)

It varies, but, yes, prior to full cerebral development, humans are less likely to handle stressful situations as well.

MILES

(standing)

Hence my rule for no one under 25! I can't have my runner panicking an hour into the game and going to the cops, or worse - getting themselves killed before our hunters have gotten their money's worth! Tina, how long have you been with me?

TINA

6 years.

MILES

I saw that potential in you; I trained you myself. We both know you're better than this.

TINA

(apologetic)

Her background was so impressive, I thought an exception could be made.

MILES

You thought wrong. I have an auction coming up in a week and no product. Where are the runner-ups?

Tina reaches into a BRIEFCASE, removes a large FILE.

TINA

25 very solid candidates.

Miles stands, moves to Tina, takes the file...

MILES

I'll determine that.

←END

He walks out. Off everyone in the room - silent. They failed.
